Above is a list of 8 of the 10 non-instructional days for 2021-2022.

- Schools will schedule the remaining two non-instructional days.
- The priority will be for these non-instructional days to focus on professional learning.
- Non-instructional time should be allocated to assessment, evaluation, and reporting -we have a standing agreement to provide teachers with time to complete report cards twice a year.
- Two half-days from the 10 non-instructional days should be provided to teachers for “classroom-based” or “self-directed” learning. Although, the professional learning is self-directed it should promote collaboration and networking between teachers and schools and be guided by our divisional priorities.
- Two of the 10 non-instructional days will promote and support our families of schools to focus on a multi-year journey. Families of schools should be mindful to include board office colleagues, divisional programs, and schools (ATC).
