Attend Personalized Professional Learning PD Series (2 full days grade K-4 / 3 full days grades 5-12). Invite colleague(s) to observe co-teaching within their classroom, and to participate in pre and post lesson reflective conversations. Examine evidence of student learning to reflect on instructional processes. 	 Participate in one lesson observation including pre and post reflection conversations. Coordinate schedules to support teachers with time to observe lessons and participate in pre and post reflective conversations. Attend one of the professional development days as a co-learner with teacher participant.

Instructional Team Member

- Plan and facilitate professional development days that foster self-directed learning based on teachers' personal learning goals.
- Co-learn with each participant based on their personal learning goal.
- Confer 1:1 with each participant at each professional development session.
- Co-plan a lesson(s) with each participant based on their personal learning goal.
- Co-teach with each participant between professional development sessions.
- Support school teams in coordinating schedules that allow for teachers to observe lessons, and participate in pre and post reflective conversations.
- Co-reflect with participant and school team observers in pre and post reflective conversations.
