

SAFE WORK PROCEDURE

Supporting Student Meetings in School for June 2020—Screening Questions COVID-19

The following questions should be asked to any student who has a scheduled in-school meeting in June at the time of arrival. These questions are part of the **Safe Work Procedure Supporting Student Meetings in School for June 2020**.

- 1. Did you complete the Manitoba Health COVID-19 online screening tool assessment before coming to school?
- 2. Do you have any flu or cold-like symptoms such as:
 - Cough
 - Fever
 - Sore throat
 - Muscle ache
 - Headache
 - Nausea
 - Runny nose
 - Fatigue

*If needed, the teacher can ask follow-up questions to determine if the student is well enough to come into the school or be directed to return home.

- 3. Have you been in contact with someone that is confirmed to have COVID-19?
- 4. Have you been notified that you were in a high risk setting for COVID-19 in the past 14 days such as on a plane or at an event?

5. Have you travelled outside of Manitoba in the last 14 days?

*Exception: Manitoban residents who regularly travel outside of Manitoba to their seasonal residences that are located close to the border do not have to self-isolate when they return to Manitoba if they are not displaying symptoms of COVID-19
