


Winnipeg is the capital of Manitoba

Louis Riel School Division International Student Program (ISP) Support System



 - Second semester February to June











Secondary/Vocational Certificate Program

Grade 11, 12 & ATC (Technical/Vocational Training)

Option 1: 2 Year Program (Sept-June)

 Transfer Grade 9-10 credits from Student's Home Country School

Year 1 - First Semester (Sept-Jan) Grade 11 Compulsory Courses

Year 1 - Second Semester (Feb-June) First Part of Trade Program

Year 2 - First Semester (Sept-Jan) Second Part of Trade Program

Year 2 - Second Semester (Feb-June) Grade 12 Compulsory Courses

Secondary/Vocational Certificate Program

Grade 12 & ATC (Technical/Vocational Training)

Option 2: 2 Year Program (Sept-June)

- Transfer Grade 9-11 credits from Student's Home Country School
- 1 year to complete Grade 12 in one of our high schools
- 1 Year to complete ATC Trade Program

*Can apply for Post Grad Work Permit





Post-Secondary Program

One Year Program (Feb-Jan or Sept-June)

- Have graduated with a Grade 12 Diploma
- Have the minimum English Language requirement of an IELTS academic score of 6.0 – 6.5 or an equivalent competency in another English Language assessment.
- Once completed, can apply for Post Grad Work Permit





What's Included In The Cost Of The Program?

- Airport Transfer- Homestay Families and International Student Program staff will greet you at the airport
- Validation of transcript
- Custodianship Documents (under the age of 18 years old)
- Excellent Health Insurance coverage-Guardme Health Insurance
- Ongoing support from International Student Program and in all schools
- Monthly activities organized by International Student Program
- Many extra-curricular activities available in all schools
- 24/7 support and monitoring of homestay
- EAL/ESL instruction and support available
- Native language support and translation


