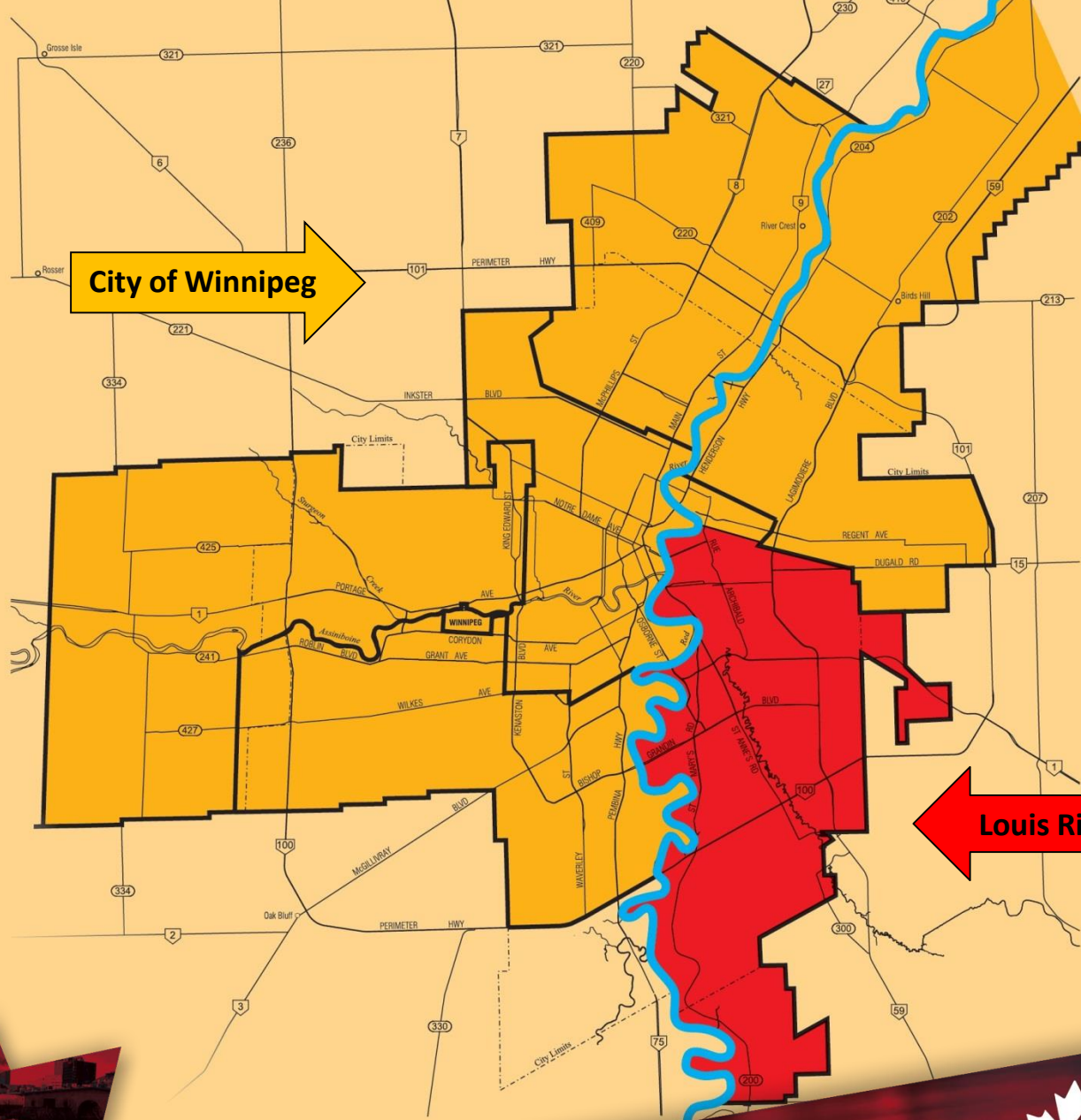

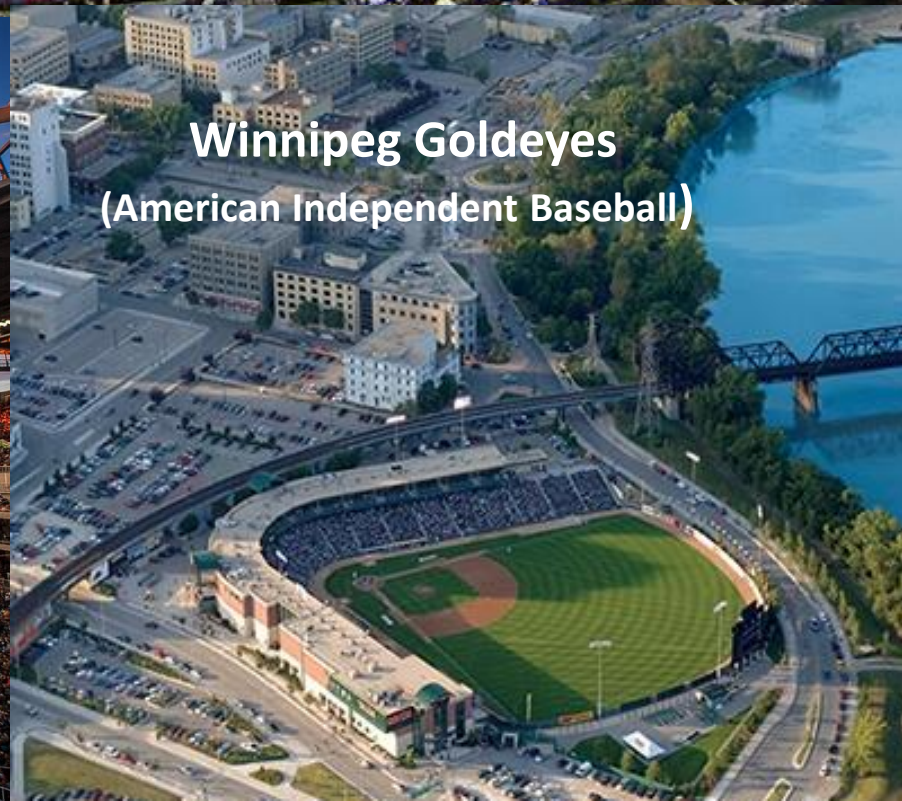

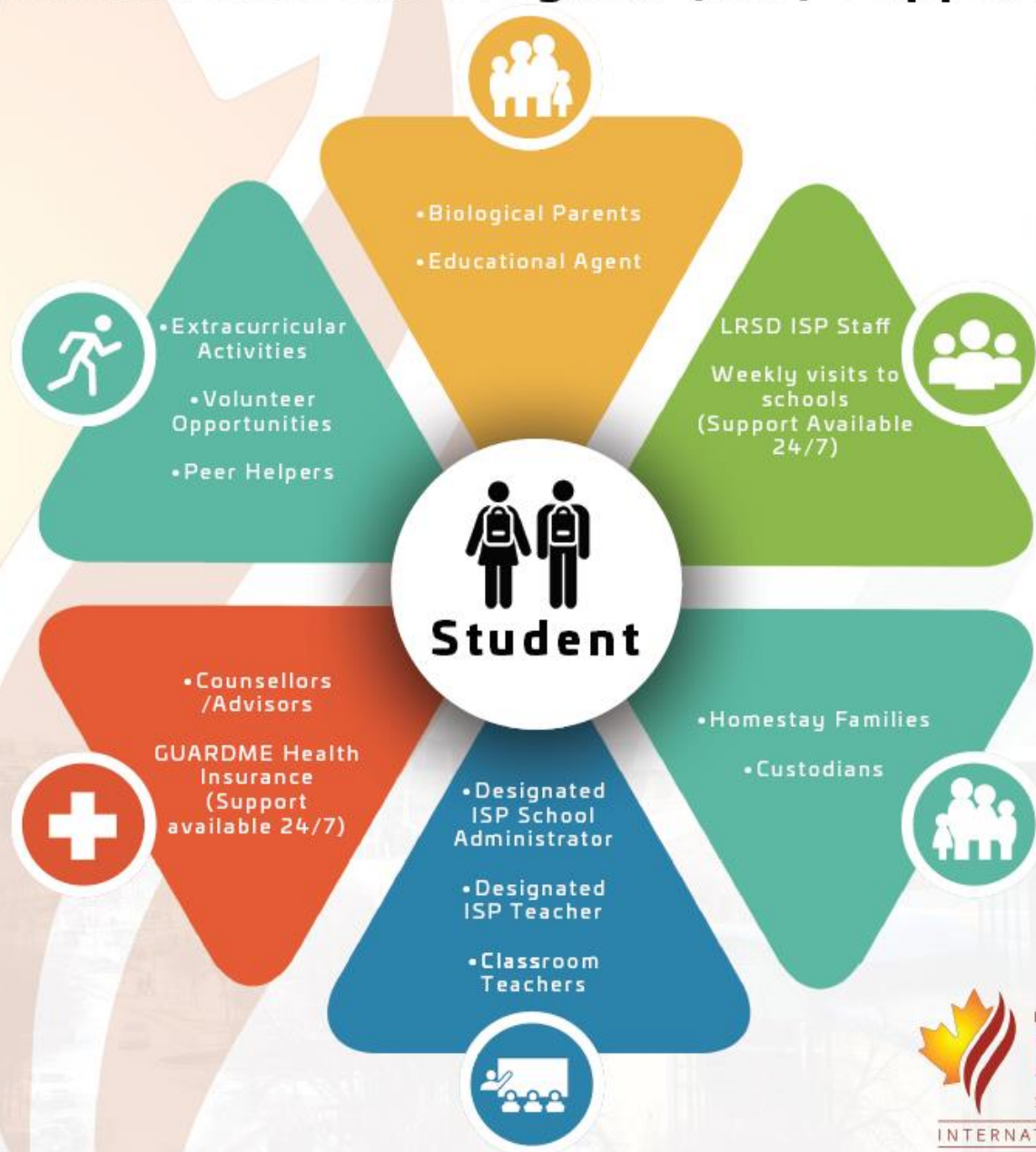

Dual Diploma Program

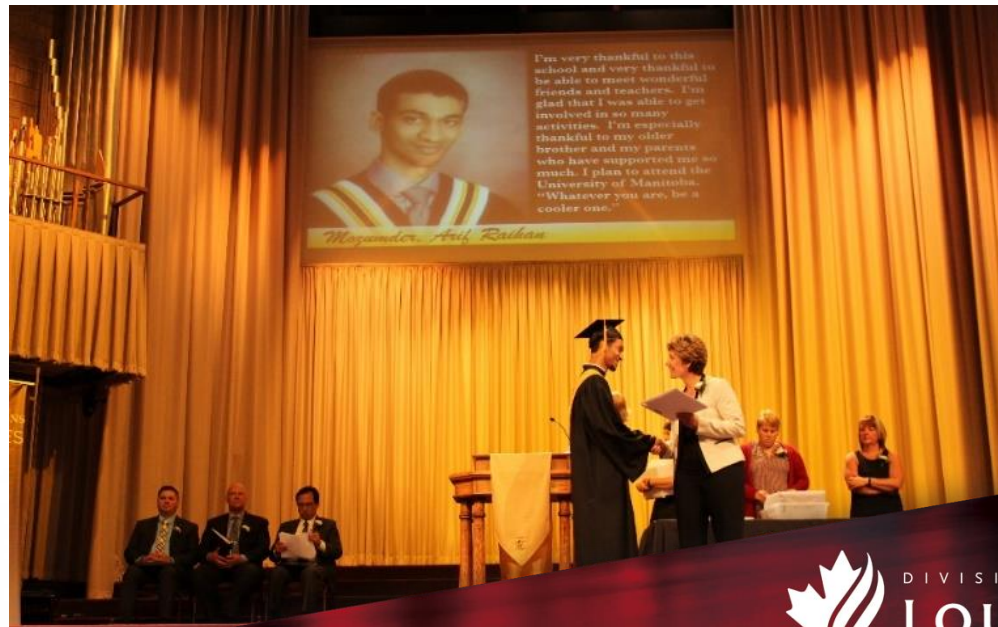


Earn two High School Diplomas, from two different countries!

Post-Secondary Program

One Year Program (Feb-Jan or Sept-June)

- Have graduated with a Grade 12 Diploma
- Have the minimum English Language requirement of an IELTS academic score of 6.0 – 6.5 or an equivalent competency in another English Language assessment.
- **Once completed, can apply for Post Grad Work Permit**

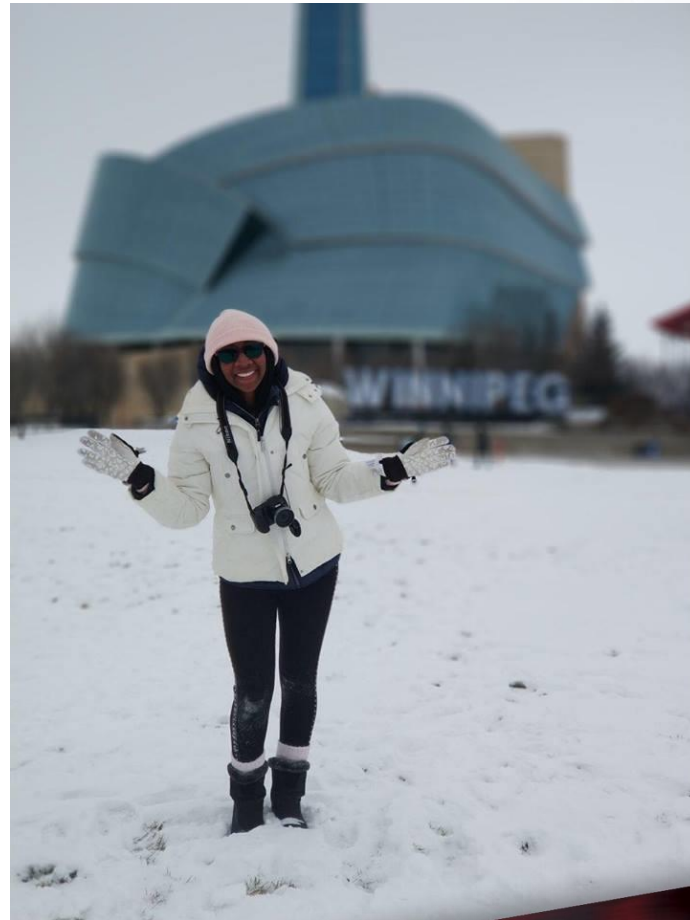


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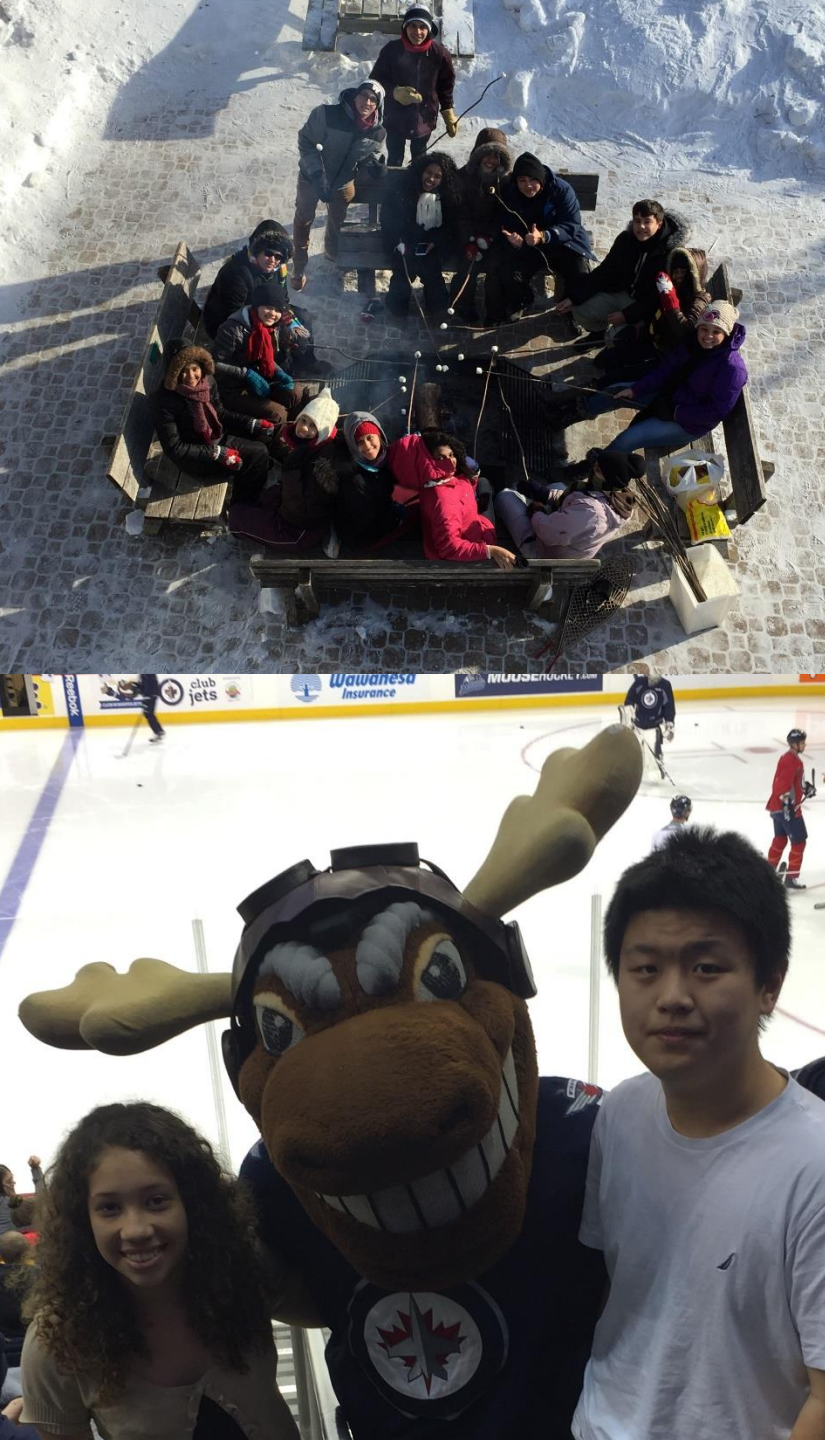
