

NMC Students Explore Careers in Health

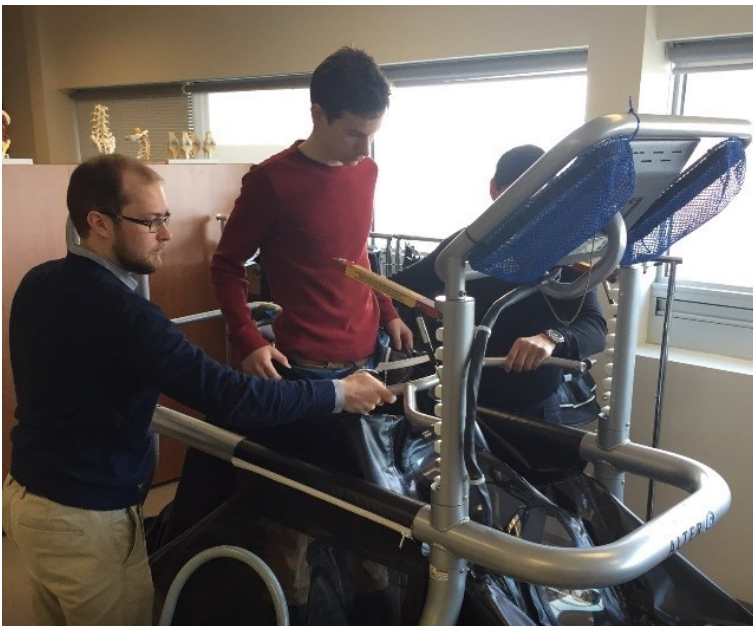
NMC Grade 9 students were treated to a wide variety of experiences and professionals in the Health Community.

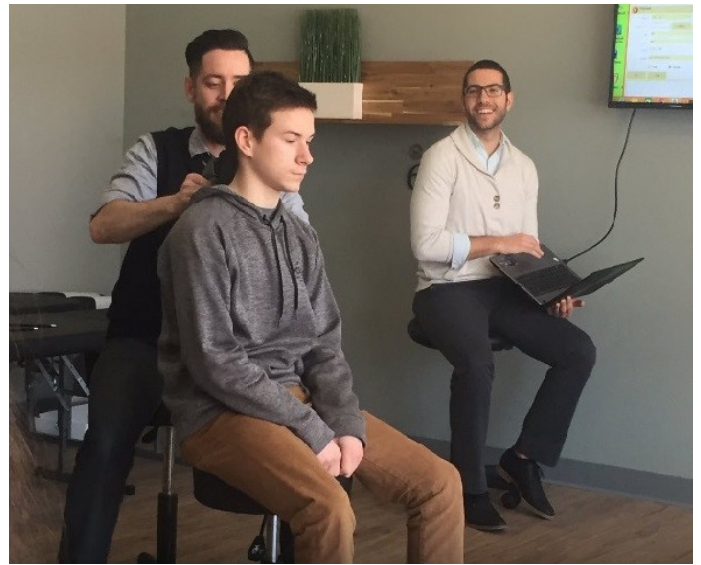
From Careers in Paramedics and Massage Therapy to careers in Athletic Therapy and Surgery, students had the opportunity to learn about and experience these different careers.
