Value: \$1500

Criteria:

- The recipient will graduate from Nelson McIntyre Collegiate.
- **Candidates will prepare a 500 to 750 word letter outlining their accomplishments in the Sciences while at Nelson McIntyre Collegiate. They will also write how they plan to further their studies in the Sciences at the Post-secondary level. The letter should be addressed to: "Ms. Catherine Anderson Frumkin"**
- The recipient will have outstanding grades to enter their post-secondary institution.
- The recipient will attend a post-secondary institution in a science related field such as medicine, nursing, engineering, education (teachables in the sciences), etc
- The recipient will have demonstrated a love of the sciences.

Deadline: The letter must be submitted to Mr. McKechnie by April 30th, 2020.

The Dr. Joseph Anderson Scholarship

The Dr. Joseph Anderson Scholarship has been established by the Anderson Family. Dr. Anderson and his sister Violet wanted to give back to the school in which they spent their teenage years. Their house on Genthon St. in Norwood still exists to this day. Violet was born on July 21st, 1916 in Ireland. Dr. Anderson was also born in Ireland on September 26th, 1921. Their family moved to the St. Boniface area when she was 10 and he was 5 years old. Both were graduates of Nelson McIntyre Collegiate in the mid to late 30's. Violet decided to remain in Winnipeg where she worked at Eaton's and then at Metropolitan Life. Joseph graduated from Harvard Medical School in 1945 and ended up moving back to Ireland for a time. When he returned to Canada he moved to Montreal and attended McGill University to further his studies. This scholarship has been established to recognize the efforts of students at Nelson McIntyre Collegiate who have excelled in the sciences and plan to further their studies in sciences at the University level.
