Re: **SCHOOL SUPPLIES**

In 2015, the Louis Riel School Division (LRSD) implemented a Standardized School Supplies program. This program assists families by providing all required school supplies for the classroom for an annual fee of \$40.00 per student in Grades 1 to 8 and \$20.00 for Kindergarten students. This fee is collected at the beginning of each school year.

The program benefits families by reducing shopping time and costs, provides high quality supplies to all students, and considers sustainable procurement practices. The LRSD is able to purchase supplies in bulk through negotiated preferential tendered pricing that is passed along to parents as reflected in the fee. Any recyclable items remaining at the end of a school year are held by the school and repurposed in the following school year to further benefit students and keep fees low.

The School Supply Fee is not intended to cover the following:

- Non-consumable Supplies such as non-marking shoes for Phys. Ed. class, dictionaries, and calculators
- Student Fees
- Lunch Supervision Fees

**Please see the “Supply List” for your child’s grade level, on the reverse side of this sheet.** The classroom supplies will be provided to students as required throughout the year. Any additional classroom supplies required will be provided by the school at no additional cost to you. Please note that, on the reverse side of this page, there is also a separate list indicating the supplies that you are expected to provide at the beginning of the school year.
